Crowdsourcing



Want thousands of dollars to fund your idea, or just to make a potato salad?

Crowdsourcing is where thousands of people support your idea by each giving you a little money in exchange for a tee-shirt, or a sample of your product when it's completed, etc.

The two most popular crowdsourcing sites are Kickstarter and Indiegogo. People typically raise \$10,000 to \$30,000 in 30 to 45 days, but can raise millions for the right idea.

Although strange things sometimes get funded – like Zach Brown who raised \$55,479 on Kickstarter to make a potato salad, and Matthew Inman who raised \$1.3 million in a month on Indiegogo to build a museum honoring Nicola Tesla, even though he had never done anything like that before, most of the funds are given to regular people trying to fund their ideas.

Government Unclaimed Property Sources.....
